Location & Directions

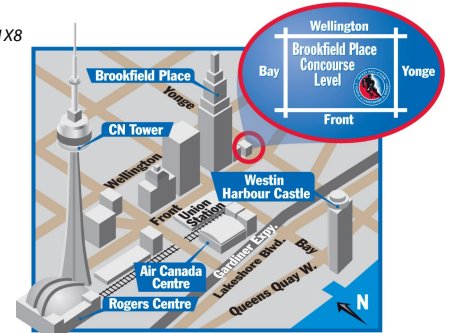
BROOKFIELD PLACE
30 Yonge Street, Toronto Ontario, Canada M5E 1X8

The entrance to the Hockey Hall of Fame is located in the concourse level of Brookfield Place, at the northwest corner of Yonge and Front Streets in downtown Toronto.

A short walk from many Toronto attractions including Air Canada Centre, CN Tower, Rogers Centre and Eaton Centre.

Transit riders may choose either King or Union Station subway stops, both of which are connected to the Hockey Hall of Fame by the underground thoroughfare.

Driving along the Gardiner Expressway, take the Yonge Street exit. Proceed northwards on Yonge to Front Street (first set of lights).
