




Honouring Hockey's Newest Legends

2008 INDUCTEES



GLENN ANDERSON | Player Category

- Recorded 30+ goals in nine of 16 NHL seasons, including career high 54-goal seasons in 1983-84 and 1985-86
- Captured five of his six Stanley Cup championships with Edmonton, scoring overtime winners and game-clinching goals in each of the Oilers' championships (1984, 1985, 1987, 1988, 1990)
- Ranks 3rd all-time amongst NHLers in overtime playoff goals (5), 5th in playoff goals (93) and 4th in playoff points (214)
- Represented Canada at the 1980 Winter Olympics, the 1984 and 1987 Canada Cups, and the 1989 and 1992 World Championships



ED CHYNOWETH | Builder Category (honoured posthumously)

- First full-time president of the Western Canada Hockey League (now WHL), presiding from 1972-1979 and 1980-1996
- Became the first Canadian Major Junior Hockey League (now CHL) president in 1975-76, a position held until 1995
- WHL Chairman of the Board from 1996-98 and 2004-07
- Awarded the CAHA Order of Merit in 1986 for outstanding service to Canadian Amateur Hockey
- Honoured with the renaming of the WHL Championship Trophy to the Ed Chynoweth Cup in May 2007



IGOR LARIONOV | Player Category

- Captured eight consecutive Russian League Championships with CSKA Moscow (1982-89)
- A 1st Team Russian All-Star on four occasions (1983, 1986, 1987, 1988) and named USSR's Player-of-the-Year in 1988
- Eight-time gold medalist including twice at the World Junior Championships (1979, 1980), four times at the World Championships (1982, 1983, 1986, 1989) and twice at the Winter Olympics (1984, 1988)
- Member of three Stanley Cup championships with the Detroit Red Wings in 1997, 1998 and 2002



RAY SCAPINELLO | Referee/Linesman Category

- Officiated his 2,500th and final NHL regular season game on April 2, 2004 in Buffalo
- NHL resume includes officiating 426 Stanley Cup playoff games, 20 Stanley Cup finals, and three All-Star games
- · Never missed a game in 33 years as an NHL Official
- · Named the NHL's "best in the business" a record 20 times
- One of the first professional officials to referee at the Winter Olympics (Nagano, 1998)
- Officiating Supervisor for the Central Hockey League since 2005
