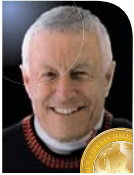

# 2017 INDUCTEES



## DAVE ANDREYCHUK | *Player Category*

- Captain of the Tampa Bay Lightning Stanley Cup championship team in 2004
- NHL's all-time powerplay scorer with 274 career goals
- Tied for third all-time in NHL history with 19 seasons of 20-or-more goals
- Ranks 14th all-time with 640 NHL regular season goals, including two 50-goal seasons: 1993 and 1994
- Retired as NHL's third-leading scorer amongst left wingers with 1,338 career points



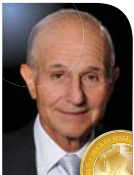
## CLARE DRAKE | *Builder Category*

- Head coach of the University of Alberta Golden Bears for 28 seasons, leading the institution to six CIAU national championships and 17 Canada West titles
- Two-time CIAU coach of the year: 1975 and 1978
- Most successful hockey coach in CIAU/CIS history with 697 wins, including a .695 winning percentage
- Head coach of Team Canada at the Spengler Cup in 1984, winning the nation's first-ever gold medal at the tournament



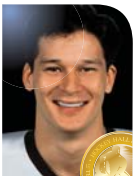
## DANIELLE GOYETTE | *Player Category*

- Eight-time gold medalist at the Women's World Championships: 1992, 1994, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2004 and 2007
- Three-time Olympian, winning gold in 2002 and 2006, and leading the tournament in goals in 1998 and tying for points in 2002
- Canada's Flag Bearer at the Opening Ceremonies of the Winter Olympic Games in Turin, Italy in 2006
- Retired as the second all-time goal scorer in Winter Olympic Games' history with 15, and fourth all-time point scorer in Women's World Championship history with 68



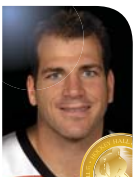
## JEREMY JACOBS | *Builder Category*

- Owner and Governor of the Boston Bruins for 42 years, 1975 to present
- During his leadership, Boston has won a Stanley Cup championship in 2011, the Presidents' Trophy twice: 1990 and 2014; and has reached the Stanley Cup Final on five occasions: 1977, 1978, 1988, 1990 and 2013
- Chairman of the NHL's Board of Governors for nine years, 2007 to present
- Recipient of the Lester Patrick Award in 2015 for outstanding service to hockey in the United States



## PAUL KARIYA | *Player Category*

- Played in seven NHL All-Star Games: 1996, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003
- Three-time NHL First Team All-Star: 1996, 1997 and 1999, and two-time Second Team All-Star: 2000 and 2003
- Two-time recipient of the Lady Byng Memorial Trophy for best combining sportsmanship and playing ability in 1996 and 1997
- Runner-up for the Hart Memorial Trophy as the league's most outstanding player in 1997
- Two-time international gold medalist with Team Canada: 1994 World Championship and 2002 Winter Olympic Games



## MARK RECCHI | *Player Category*

- Member of three Stanley Cup championship teams: Pittsburgh Penguins in 1991, Carolina Hurricanes in 2006 and Boston Bruins in 2011, and oldest player to score in a Stanley Cup Final at age 43
- NHL Second Team All-Star in 1992 and finalist for Lester B. Pearson Award in 1999-2000
- Third most prolific scorer in NHL history amongst right wingers with 1,533 regular season points
- Two-time international gold medalist with Team Canada: 1988 World U20 Championship and 1997 World Championship



## TEEMU SELANNE | *Player Category*

- Recipient of 1993 Calder Memorial Trophy, 1999 Maurice "Rocket" Richard Trophy and 2006 Bill Masterton Memorial Trophy
- Two-time NHL First Team All-Star: 1993 and 1997, and Second Team All-Star: 1998 and 1999
- Member of the Anaheim Ducks Stanley Cup championship team in 2007
- Ranks eleventh all-time in NHL history with 684 career regular season goals
- Six-time Olympian as member of Team Finland and tournament's most prolific scorer with 43 career points
