- > All in-venue bids shall be recorded via the touch screen terminals outside of *Starbuck's in the Brookfield Place Concourse.*
- ➤ Until 9:55 p.m. on November 14, 2011, raised bids ("Highest Bids") will be concurrently updated and displayed on the large screen/monitors.
- ➤ At 9:55 p.m. sharp on November 14, 2011, the "Highest Bids" displays will be frozen and all registered participants will have an opportunity to make a *Final Bid* on any number of items (the computer will allow each participant only one *Final Bid* per item and will reject bids lower than the "Highest Bids" posted as of 9:55 p.m.).
